

Cherry Blossom Walks and 5K Runs for Breast Cancer, Oct. 9, 2011

The fifth annual Cherry Blossom Walks and 5K Runs for Breast Cancer, organized by the Cherry Blossom Breast Cancer Foundation, will be held simultaneously in Leesburg, Middleburg, and Warrenton.

The theme of the fundraiser is "Pick Up the Pace for the Cure".

This family event, which raises money for the Fauquier and Loudoun fight against breast cancer, has a two-mile walk and 5K run for families.
